

Home Testing Guidance

- There are three tests in each kit; the intention is that students are tested every 3 to 4 days. The kits we have just issued will cover the three weeks until the Easter break. If parents and other family members living with students would like to take part in testing, they are entitled to collect or request kits:

- You also have an instruction booklet for their use. It is important that you follow the instructions in this new booklet and discard the one included in each of the boxes.

- Once a test has been completed, it is important that the outcome is shared with both NHS Test and Trace **and** Sixth Form. This should be for all outcomes - positive, negative or void.

- In the event of a positive outcome:
 - **you will need to inform Sixth Form.**
 - you and anyone you live with should self-isolate immediately
 - you should [report your rapid lateral flow test result on GOV.UK](#) as soon as possible
 - you should [get a PCR test to check if you have coronavirus on GOV.UK](#)
 - you should continue to self-isolate until you get the result of the PCR test and follow the advice you're given when you get the result.
